## *Craft Vendor Application*

From foot races, greased pig contests, hotdogs, music, crafters and more events than you can count all the way to the grand finale fireworks, people come to Murphy, NC to enjoy an old fashioned, fun-filled celebration of our country's birthday. Sponsored by the Business Women of Cherokee county and held at Konehete Park, the 4th of July celebration draws visitors from near and far.

**Craft Vendors** are invited to participate with the following rules:

1. Only original works approved on the application may be displayed and sold
2. All items must be designed and created by the artist. No kit-made items, manufactured items, items bought or consigned for resale or "flea market" items will be allowed.
3. All exhibitors must provide their own tents, shelving, tables and chairs.
4. The celebration will be held—rain or shine. Hours are 10 am to 5 pm on Saturday, July 4th, 2009. Vendors are required to stay for the entire time. Vendors are encouraged to stay beyond 5 pm as the fireworks display will begin at dark.
5. Vendors are responsible for collecting & reporting NC sales tax.
6. Vendors are encouraged to decorate their booths in keeping with the 4th of July theme. Booths will be judged between 9:45 and 10:15 am. A prize will be awarded for the 1st place booths and ribbons for the 2nd & 3rd place booths.
7. Parking is limited to no more than 2 vehicles per booth space. Parking permits will be issued for vendor parking.
8. Registration/setup will be from 7:00 am—9:45 am. Packets will have space assignments, etc. All vehicles **MUST** be removed from the area no later than 9:45 am
9. Participation fee is \$35 per 10 x 10 space. Business Women of Cherokee County member fee is \$25 per 10 x 10 space.
